AL-SHIFA TRUST OPENS INTERIM EYE CLINIC IN GILGIT AHEAD OF HOSPITAL COMPLETION



Al-Shifa Trust has inaugurated an interim eye clinic near the construction site of its upcoming seventh eye hospital in Gilgit. The clinic, housed in a rented building, was officially opened on December 17, 2024. Health Minister of Gilgit, Raja Azam Khan performed the ribbon-cutting ceremony.

The interim clinic aims to provide immediate access to comprehensive eye care services while construction of the permanent hospital, which began in July 2024, continues. The hospital is expected to be completed by June 2026.

President Al-Shifa Trust, Maj Gen (R) Rehmat Khan, was unable to attend due to flight cancellation but facilitated remotely. His message was delivered by Col. Siraj Ahmed, GM Projects. The ceremony was also attended by newly appointed doctors of Gilgit Hospital, representatives from Al-Shifa Trust and Rupani Foundation, senior government officials, and other distinguished guests.

The clinic is now open, offering comprehensive eye care services to the community.

RARE LIFE-SAVING SURGERY RESTORES SIGHT OF NEWBORN.


A team of specialists at Al-Shifa Trust Eye Hospital successfully treated a rare congenital eye tumour, saving both the vision and life of a newborn.

Mirha Ameer, an infant from Gujar Khan, was diagnosed with a life-threatening eye tumour shortly after birth, endangering her sight and survival. After a week of seeking consultations at various hospitals, her parents turned to Al-Shifa Trust Eye Hospital for a solution.

The tumour was three times larger than the size of her eyeball and the girl was in life-threatening condition, prompting



doctors to urgently perform complex surgery, which continued for two and a half hours and concluded successfully. Prof. Dr. Tayyab Afghani, Dr. Mansoorul Haq, Dr. Shumaila Niazi, Dr. Umera Asad, Dr. Asfandyar Amirzada, and Dr. Muhammad Tariq are among the team members who removed the tumour.

NEW INITIATIVES

NEW OPD BLOCK AT AL SHIFA TRUST EYE HOSPITAL RAWALPINDI

A new Outpatient Department (OPD) block has been planned to accommodate the increasing number of patients seeking our specialized care. The project's estimated cost is 1 Billion PKR, with a covered area of 120,000 square feet, equipped with state-of-the-art infrastructure. Al-Shifa Trust is reaching out to philanthropic individuals and organizations to join hands and contribute to this initiative and help us continue providing accessible advanced eye care services to those in need.

NEW EYE HOSPITAL IN GILGIT

Al-Shifa Trust is building a new eye hospital in Gilgit. The land for this hospital has been generously donated by the Government of Gilgit-Baltistan. The groundbreaking ceremony of the hospital was held in July 2024. The Rupani Foundation has committed to contributing 50% of the construction cost. Another potential donor has also pledged 40 Million PKR towards the project. An additional 90 Million PKR and 100 Million PKR are required for the completion of the construction and equipment, respectively.

CONSTRUCTION OF EYE HOSPITAL IN HAVELI LAKHA

A generous donor of Al-Shifa Trust has donated land for a new eye hospital in Haveli Lakha, a city in Depalpur Tehsil of Okara District. The new hospital is strategically placed to serve newer communities that are currently at a greater distance from Al-Shifa's seven operational hospitals.

AL-SHIFA TRUST EYE HOSPITAL IN LAHORE

Recognizing Al-Shifa Trust's excellent reputation in Pakistan, the Government of Punjab has agreed to grant a 68-kanal land for the construction of Al-Shifa Trust Eye Hospital in Lahore. We are currently accepting donations for this new project.

PLAN FOR AL-SHIFA TRUST EYE HOSPITAL IN QUETTA

A hospital has been planned in Quetta to extend eye care services for the people of Balochistan. Currently, Al-Shifa Trust is seeking donors for the planned facility.
